**iPhoto 1.1**, a free application recently released by Apple, is an ideal tool for importing, organizing, editing (to a certain degree), and sharing your digital photos. iPhoto provides several ways to share photos: create a slide show complete with music; use a color inkjet printer to print your photos in a variety of sizes; upload selected photos to Apple, which will have them printed and returned directly to you or, if you prefer, display them on your iTools web page; design a professional looking “coffee table” book complete with captions—upload it to Apple and, for a fee, a linen covered album, in your color choice, is produced and returned to you.
