Using the Canon Scanner

The Canon scanner (CanoScan N670U) is easy to use and setup. Follow the directions in the Quick Start guide that comes with your scanner to install all of the software that comes with the scanner. With the different applications that are included with the scanner, you will be able to scan pictures and text, modify and alter pictures, and even email your pictures straight from the scanner. This scanner is very light and uses power from the computer via the USB cable. Try scanning some pictures and see how easy it is!



Alert!

Make sure you unlock the scanner before you start. You may also have to remove any tape that seals the scanner. Lock the scanner when you transport it.



Tip!

Create an alias (Mac) or shortcut (PC) for PhotoStudio to start the program.

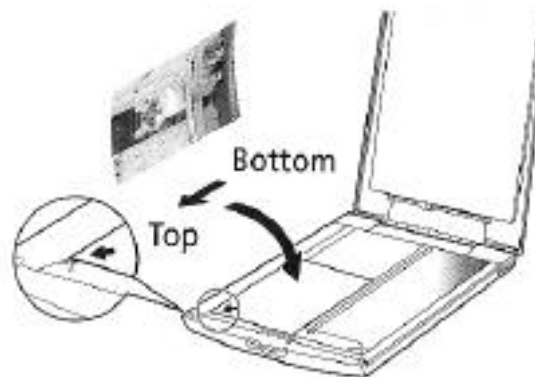


Check it

Place a Photo or Item in the Scanner

1. Plug the USB cable into the scanner and computer.
2. Place the item face down at the top edge at the front left corner of the glass.
