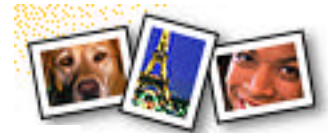




Modify and Send Images

Get your Photo

First you need to have a photo to get. PhotoDeluxe asks you to choose where you have your photo.

You will need the PhotoDeluxe CD for the Sample Photos and Clip Art. If you do not have it available, take your own pictures or go to the Internet to sites that offer copyright free images such as www.pics4learning.com

- My Photos are photos you have saved in PhotoDeluxe's folder.
- Sample Photos are samples that PhotoDeluxe included.
- Clip Art are graphic images not photos that are included with PhotoDeluxe such as the Chicken to the right.
- Open File means you have to navigate to the file saved on your computer, server, removable drive, or disk that has your images.
- Cameras, Scanners, and the rest will ask for an Input Device or source.



Get a Photo from the Internet

1. Go to <http://www.pics4learning.com>. (free copyright-free images from Techlearning.com)
2. Go to *Monuments and National Parks* to the picture of Mt. Rushmore.
3. Select the picture and save to your desktop or documents folder.

- PC users : select image with left button, click with right button to bring up contextual menu, then save image.
- Mac users: select image and hold mouse button down to bring up contextual menu, then save image.
