



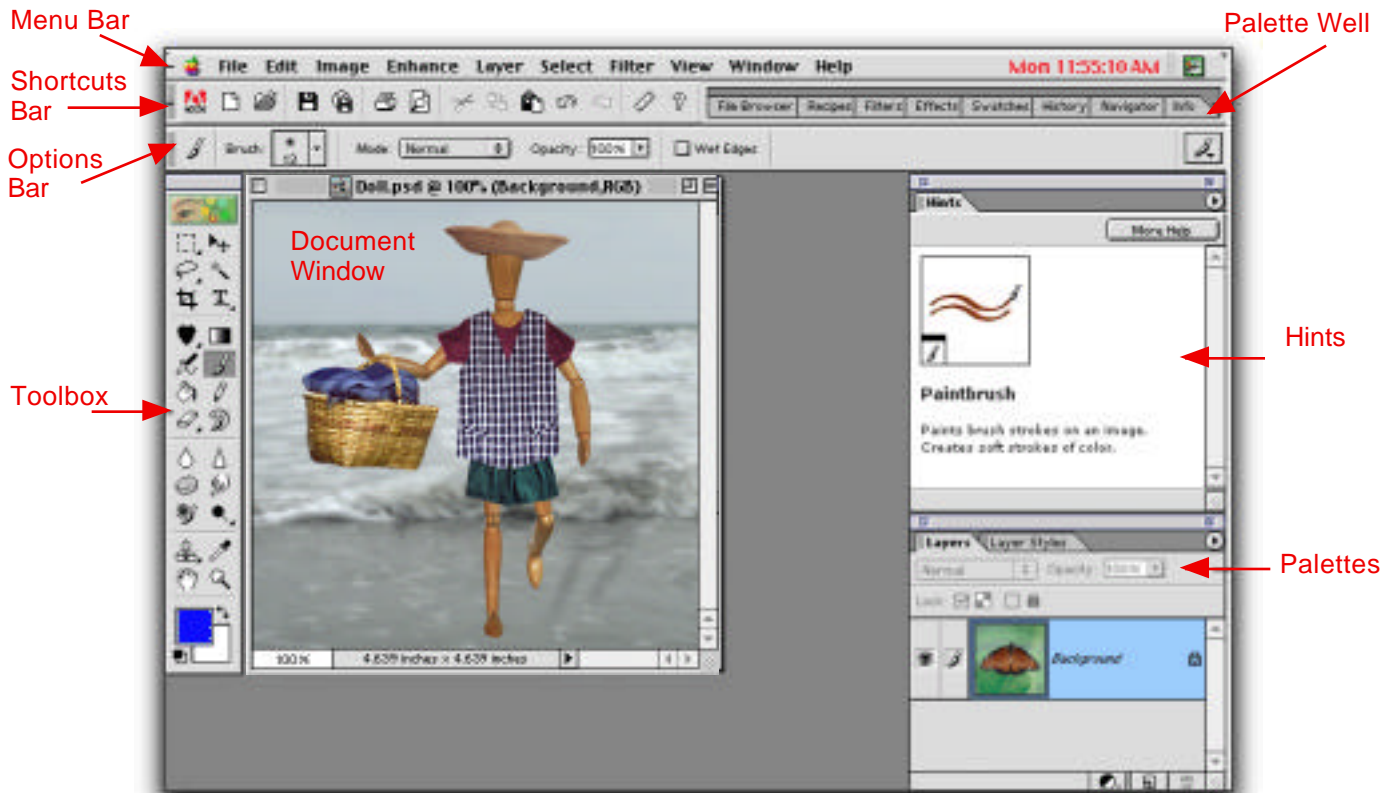

Import an Image

1. Go to the **File** menu to **Open** or click **Open** in the Shortcuts Bar.
2. Navigate to the PhotoShop Elements folder to the Tutorials folder to the file "Start.psd."
3. You will notice multiple layers will show in the Palettes.
4. If the layers do not show, go to the **Window** menu to **Show Layers**.
