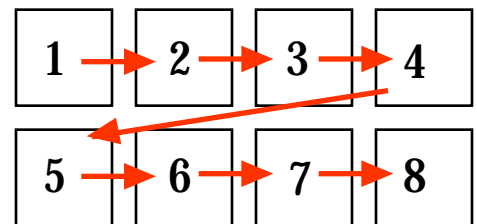
Collect the pictures your students have drawn and use those for a slide show. Create a title page. Great for Open House or Back to School Nights to show off student projects.

Prepare Pictures for Slide Show

1. Create and name a folder for your slides (pictures). Make sure you remember where you put the folder and what you call it.
2. Collect all the pictures you want for your presentation.
3. Plan and storyboard your slide show by deciding which picture goes first then next and so on.
4. Save your pictures to that folder, or put all the pictures you want to use into your new folder.

Open SlideShow

1. Open Kid Pix and choose SlideShow from the main menu.
2. There are up to 99 moving trucks that represent each slide in your slide show. This is your slide show layout.
3. All buttons on the truck labeled below can be used for each slide.
4. As you complete each step, the buttons fill in, right now they are empty
