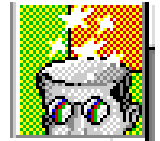

Visual learning is a great way for students of all ages to graphically work with ideas and present information. Inspiration helps you create webs, idea and concept maps, outlines, and storyboards for brainstorming and organizing your ideas for writing or presentations. With RapidFire, you can quickly create word associations, idea maps, concept maps, flow charts, and much more. Use the extensive symbol library to enhance your diagram and then transform it into an outline that can be exported to use in other documents. Check out the built-in templates. You will find these are a great way to start using Inspiration.



Reference!

Inspiration always starts in the diagram view. You can set the default symbol and font using diagram properties.

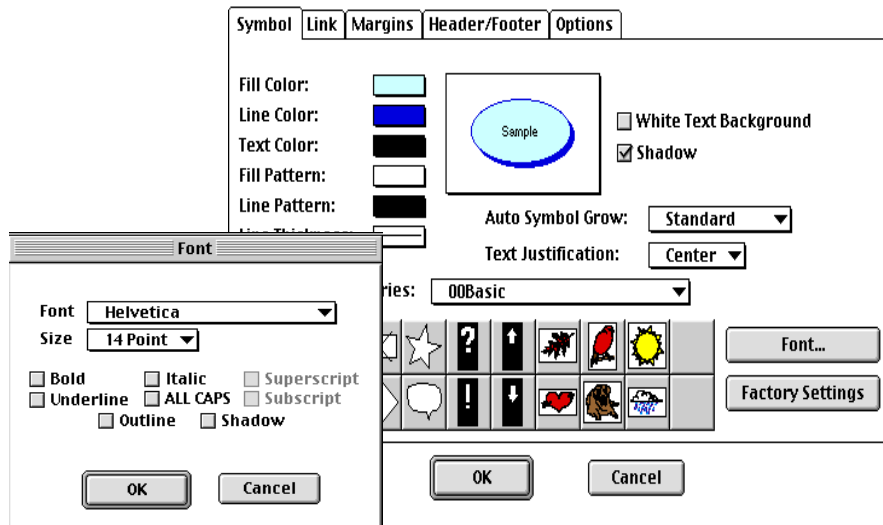


Tip!

If you use Inspiration for brainstorming with a computer attached to a TV monitor, you might want to make the font at least 14-18 pt so those in the back of the room can read the information on the symbols.

Start Inspiration

1. A symbol labeled Main Idea will appear in diagram view. You cannot delete this symbol. It is your "main idea."
2. Select the text and type in your main idea—the title of your project, the main idea you plan to brainstorm about, etc.



Change the Font

1. Go to the **Format** menu to Size.
2. Change the font size to 14 pt.
This only changes the font size and type of the main idea.
3. Go to the **File** menu to Diagram Properties...
4. Click on **Font...** and change **size**.
5. Click **OK** twice.
