A stack is made up of a series of connecting cards. You can always create branching stacks that allow the user to make different choices and take different paths throughout the stack.



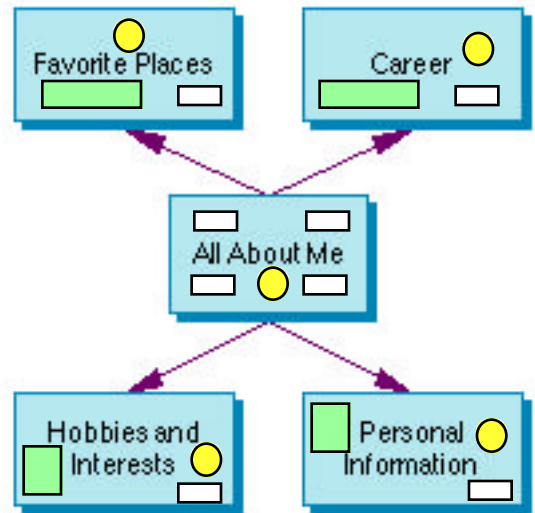
Tip!

Think about and find images and sounds you might want to add to each card before you start your stack. Create a folder to store these files. You can even save text files to import later.



Plan and Storyboard Your Stack

1. Plan the text for each of your topic cards.
2. Collect images and sounds you would like to add to your cards and store in a folder on the desktop.
3. Using index cards or a program like Inspiration, plan how your text , images and buttons may appear on each card and will link to each other.



Start a New Stack

1. Start Hyperstudio 3.2.
