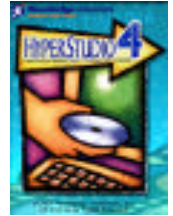




Create an All About Me Stack



Hyperstudio 4 is a multimedia program that allows you to incorporate text, pictures, sound, animation, web links, and much more. This step-by-step guide will show you how to use Hyperstudio 3.2 to create a sample stack that contains five different cards titled "All About Me." Feel free to add or change the card topics to personalize your stack.



Reference!

A stack is made up of a series of connecting cards. You can always create branching stacks that allow the user to make different choices and take different paths throughout the stack.



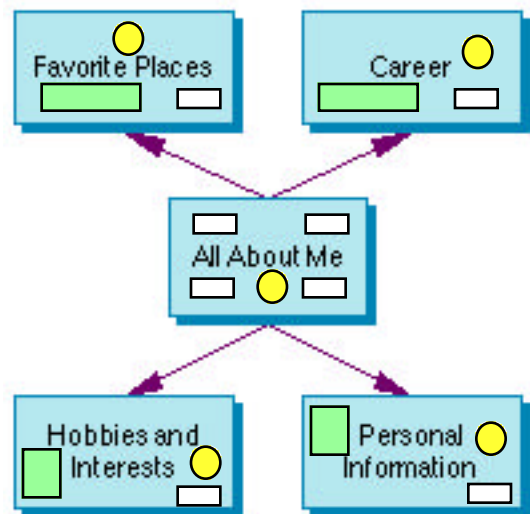
Tip!

Think about and find images and sounds you might want to add to each card before you start your stack. Create a folder to store these files. You can even save text files to import later.



Plan and Storyboard Your Stack

1. Plan the text for each of your topic cards.
2. Collect images and sounds you would like to add to each of your cards and store in a folder on the desktop.
3. Using index cards or a program like Inspiration, plan how your text , images , and buttons may appear on each card and link to each other.



Start a New Stack

1. Start Hyperstudio 4.
2. Click on the **Create a New Stack** button.
3. Click **OK** which brings you to your new blank card of your new stack..



You've just created a new stack, it is called "Untitled" and you are on the first card. You can now paint with the paint tools, add buttons and use "New Card" to add more cards.
